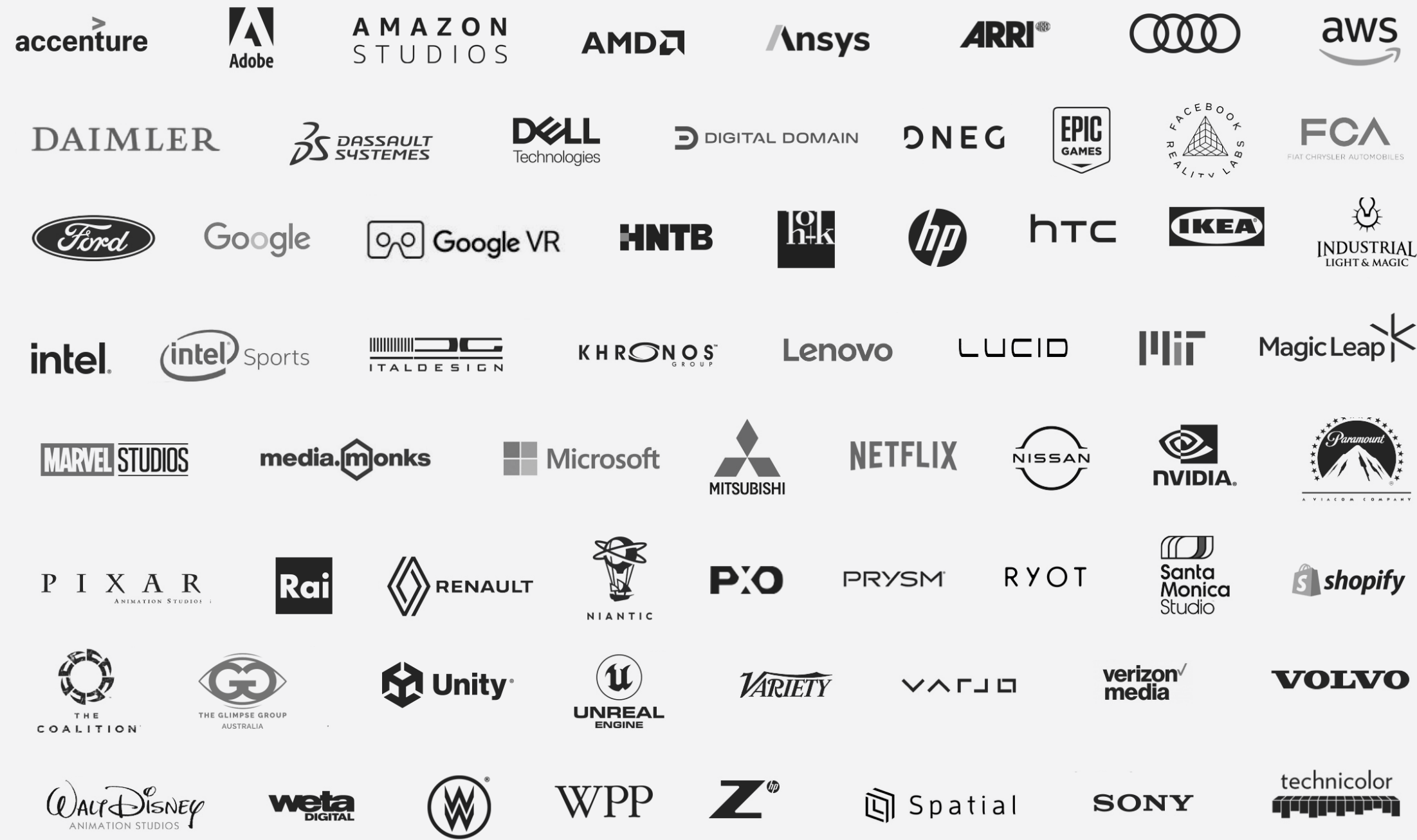

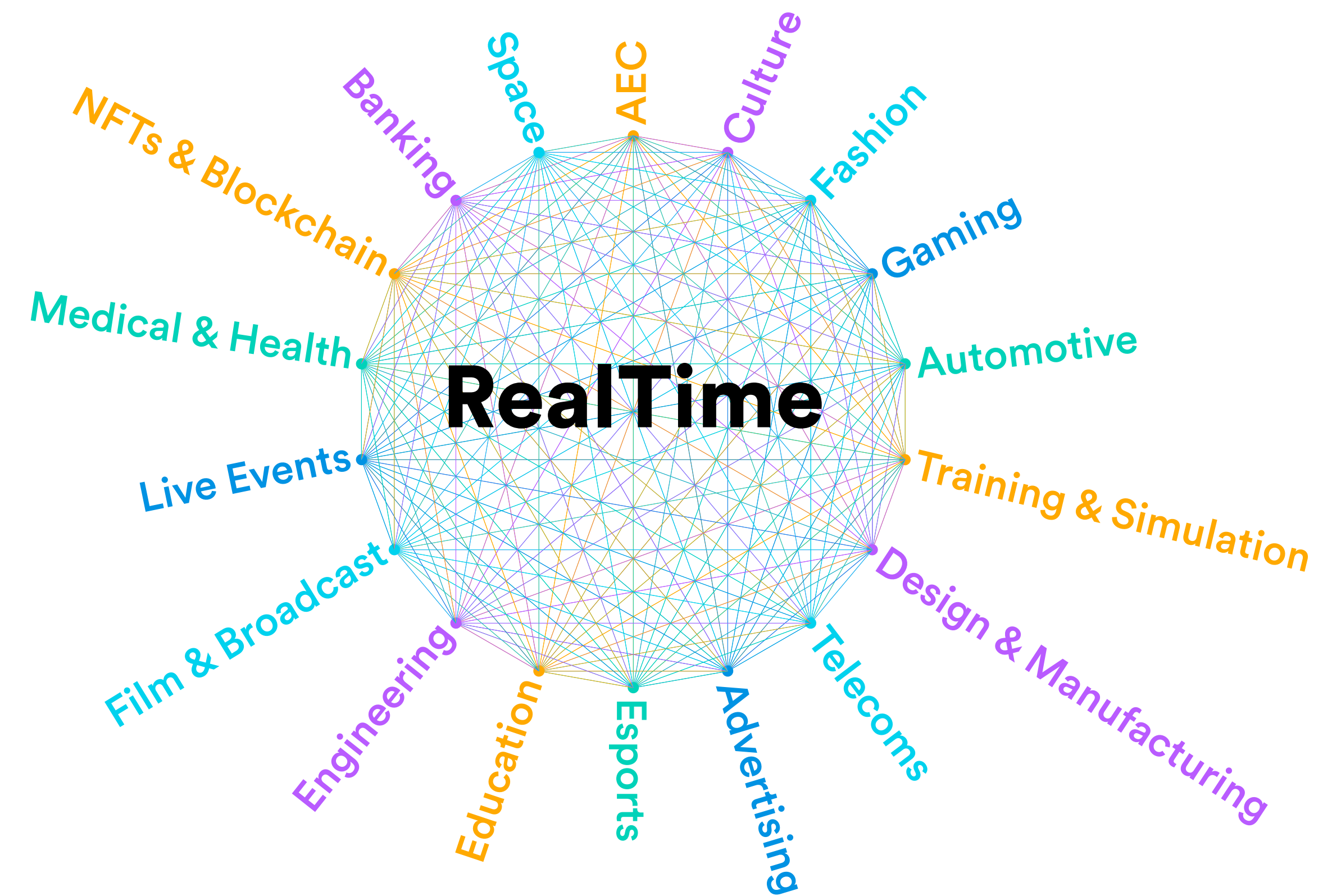
The 2023 **RealTime Economics Summit** is coming to New York on May 15 & 16.

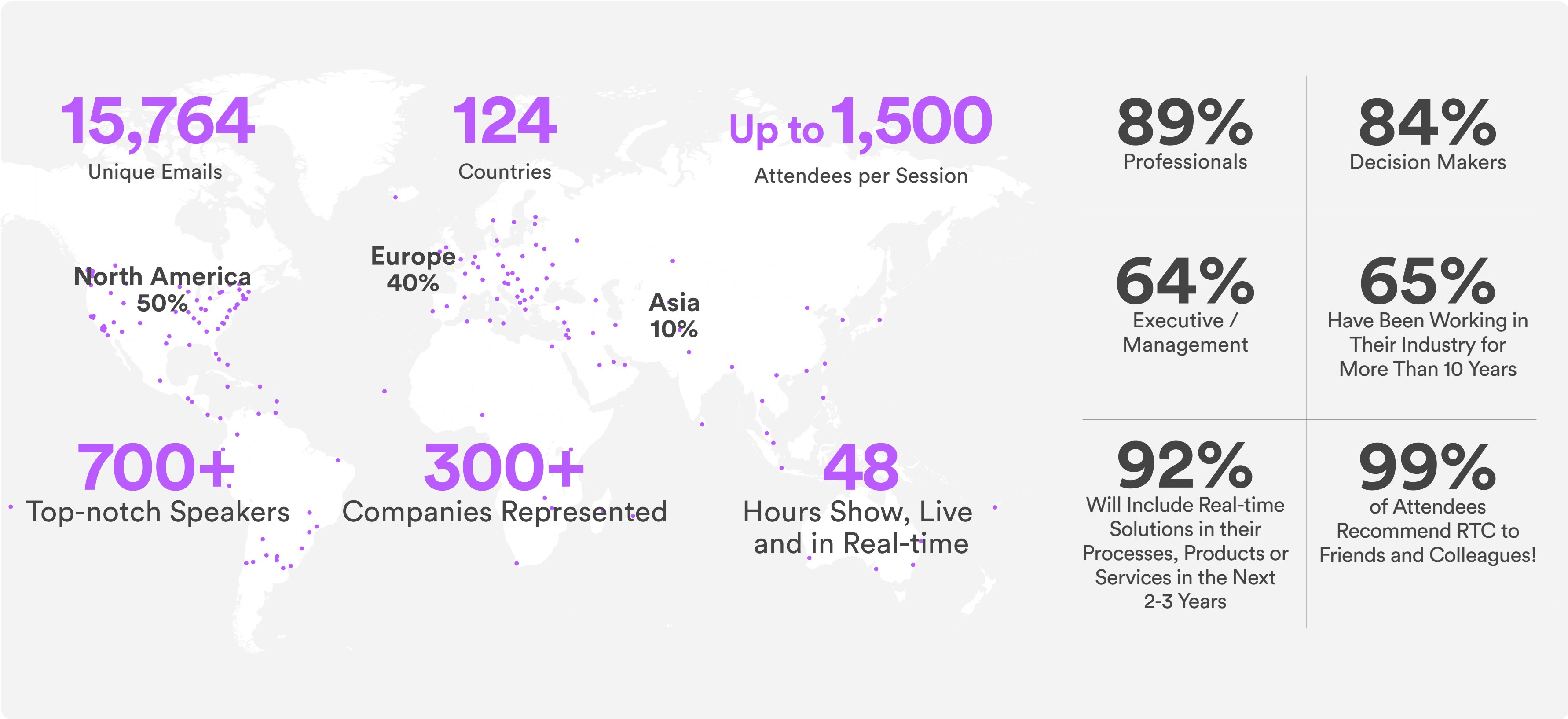


# Hosts of the World’s Premiere Event for Real-Time Technologies
