The Need for a Summit on the Economics of Real-Time Technologies


The 2023 RealTime Economics Summit is coming to New York on May 15 & 16.




Hosts of the World's Premiere Event for Real-Time Technologies

With 23,866 participants since its inception in April 2020, RTC has established itself as the world's premiere event for real-time technologies.


RealTime Community is now launching RealTime Economic Summit to meet the needs of executive decision-makers in its global network.

RTES takes place at the Museum of the Moving Image, located in a former building of the historic Astoria Studios, in Queens, New York City.

- RTES is a curated gathering, for 250 executives from real-time industries.
- Registration is invitation-only.
- The vast majority of the event is peer to peer: intimate roundtables, closed-door workshops, and networking events make up 80 percent of the schedule.
- Cameras off: to facilitate honesty and free exchange, no part of the event will be recorded.

Strategic Keynotes and Straightforward Fireside Chats

Each day will be framed by top-notch keynote presentations and fireside chats with leading innovators.

These plenary talks provide insight on economic issues rippling across industries and how real-time technologies promise to address those challenges, giving attendees key context for the day's discussion.



Closed-Door Working Sessions & Intimate Roundtables

Closed-Door Working Sessions are in-depth discussions of the issues that matter most.

- 20 to 25 participants gather to discuss real-time economics and issues specific to their industry
- Experienced moderators guide the discussion.
- An officially designated reporter records key-takeaways and presents conclusions to the wider RTES audience.
- Working Sessions take place in a private break-out space, facilitating candor and open discussion.

Roundtables are open, informal conversations on topics that concern the entire RealTime Community.

- Roundtables occur simultaneously in a shared space, allowing participants to take part in multiple conversations. Each roundtable will sit 10 participants, including the table leader.
