Monday 8 to Thursday 11 September

Tube

- Disruption expected across Tube network
- Little to no service running
- No service before 08:00
- Complete your journey by 18:00

DLR

- Tuesday 9 and Thursday 11 September only: no DLR service due to strike
- All other days: full service
- Stations shared with Tube services: possible disruption

Elizabeth line

- There are no strikes on the Elizabeth line
- Stations shared with Tube services: possible disruption
- Trains will not stop at stations between Whitechapel and Bond Street at these times:
 - Monday 8 and Wednesday 10 September before 07:30 and after 22:30
 - Tuesday 9 and Thursday 11 September before 08:00

Friday 12 September

Tube

- No service before 08:00
- Normal service on all lines by late morning

DLR

- Normal service

Elizabeth line

- Normal service

Other services

Other TfL services, including the Elizabeth line, London Overground and trams, will be running on strike days.

- Services will be extremely busy
- Some services may be unable to stop at all stations or run to their normal destination at times
